I. Council Action Requested.

To appoint Judy Vance as Registrar of Voters to serve a two-year term.

II. Basis for Council Action.

Council approval of this item is required because;

- a. The article proposes the appointment, by the municipal officers, of a position required by Maine statute (21-A M.R.S.A. § 101, see attached), and
- b. The Town Council ‘shall be and constitute the municipal officers of the Town” pursuant to Article II, Section 1 of the Charter.

III. Issue Summary.

The current Registrar of Voters is Judy Vance; Judy has been the appointed Registrar of Voters since December 12, 2002. Under state law, the municipal officers appoint the Registrar of Voters for two-year terms by January 1st of each odd-numbered year. Town Clerk Linda Morrell recommends the appointment of Judy Vance to serve another term. Judy takes great pride in doing this job, and she has a wealth of knowledge in this area.
