I. Council Action Requested.

To award a bid for the purchase of one (1) 2018 cab and chassis from Daigle and Houghton in the amount of \$91,500.00 plus \$1,200 for on board diagnostic equipment and software for a total of \$92,700.00 and related plow and sanding gear from HP Fairfield in the amount of \$74,999, for a total price of \$167,699.00 less trade of \$32,500 for a final cost of \$135,199. II. Basis for Council Action.
