## I. Council Action Requested.

To find that the requirements of 28-A M.R.S.A. § 653 have been met and to approve an application submitted by Math-Copper LLC d/b/a Bob's Seafood for a new Liquor License.

II. Basis for Council Action.

Council approval of this item is required because;

- a) 28-A M.R.S.A. § 653 requires the municipal officers to act on applications for liquor licenses; or, if they fail to act within sixty (60) days, the application will be deemed to be approved by the municipal officers and ready for action by the Bureau of Liquor Enforcement, and
- b) Pursuant to Article II, Section 1 of the Charter "[t]he Town Council, hereinafter called the 'Council', shall be and constitute the municipal officers of the Town."
