I. Council Action Requested.

To enter into executive session under 1 M.R.S.A. §405(6)(A), which provides for the "Discussion or consideration of the employment, appointment, assignment, duties, promotion, demotion, compensation, evaluation, disciplining, resignation or dismissal of an individual or group of public officials, appointees or employees of the body or agency," for the purpose of interviewing candidates to fill a vacant Council seat.

II. Basis for Council Action.

Council approval of this item is required because;

- The proposed article contemplates discussion of matters in executive session as permitted by statute, and
- The Town Council is the legislative body of the Town pursuant to Article II, Section 3(I) of the Charter.

III. Issue Summary.
