I. Council Action Requested.

To decommission the Public Easement Advisory Committee, and to express the Council's profound gratitude and appreciation on behalf of the town and its residents for the work of the committee and all of its members.

II. Basis for Council Action.

Council approval of this item is required because;

- a. According to Article II, Section 3(C) of the Charter, the Town Council has the authority to “[a]ppoint... the membership of such advisory committees as the Council shall create,” and
- b. The committee being proposed for decommissioning was established by order of the Council.

III. Issue Summary.

The work performed by this committee was on private roads that now fall under the purview of Windham's private and special law LD 1975, Town Code Chapter 204 Streets and Sidewalks Article III Designated Private Ways and the Town's Road Commissioner, whether that be one individual or a group of individuals.
